5 verses, 5 Questions, 5 minutes

You are Mine!

Ask God to forgive you for any transgressions you have committed and open His word to your heart. Please Read Malachi 3:14-18.

**Have you ever felt that the wicked seem have an easy life while you struggle to make ends meet?**

**Do the wicked really go unpunished?**

Verse 16 states that "then those who feared the Lord spoke to one another." The word for *fear* in this verse is *yare'* which means to "fear, revere, reverence, honor, to inspire reverence and to stand in awe of" (BLB).

**What do you think "those who feared the Lord" said to each other?**

**What amazing thing did the Lord do for those who feared Him and meditated on His Name?**

I never thought the Lord would be into scrapbooking! I can just imagine God pouring over His remembrance books, reliving all those special moments of your life, rejoicing at each step and stage of growth as I have savored photos of my family.

**What two words does God use in verse 17 for those who fear Him?**

God uses the words *Mine* and *jewels*. Did you notice the word *My* that is in front of *jewels*? The Hebrew word for jewels is *cagullah* which means "valued property, peculiar treasure, particular treasure and special." Please hear these words down to the bottom of your soul:

*"You are His great treasure. You are valuable and particularly special to Him. He Loves you!"*
