At first, when I considered the above characteristics, I must confess I knew I didn't measure up. I dreaded looking up the meaning of the word *blameless* because I know I'm not and I want to dwell in the house of the Lord. Relief and thankfulness brought tears tomy eyes as I read the following definition for *tamiym*, the Hebrew word for *blameless* which means *complete*, *whole*, *sound*, *having integrity*. Notice nothing is mentioned about having perfect records, zero mistakes or faultless performance.

Why is it important that we speak the truth in our hearts?

Those who dwell in His presence do not what (verses 3-5)?

Of all the things that a person who dwells on the Holy Hill does and does not do, which is the hardest for you?

Take a moment to pray about the issue you just listed.
