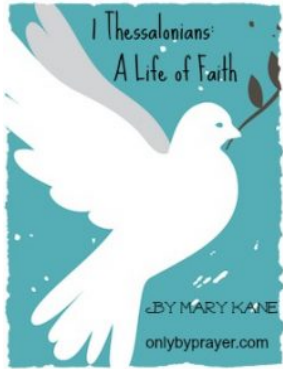


1 Thessalonians, A Life of Faith, Part 16: The Quiet Life
