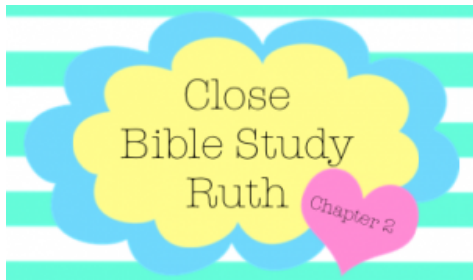


# Close Bible Study: Ruth Part 2 by Mary Kane

When readers interact *rigorously* with the text, comprehension and retention sky rocket.
