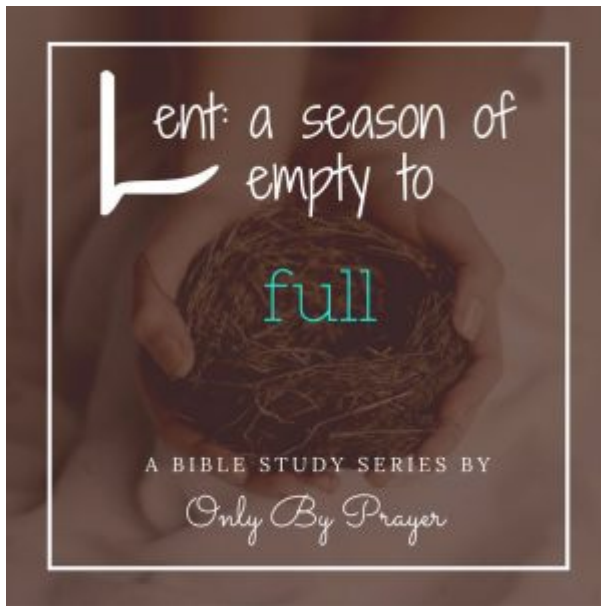


Study, Lent: empty to full
