Please take a moment and go before God in prayer. Confess to Him any sin and ask Him to fill you with His Holy Spirit. Now please read Psalm 1:1-5.

What three things does a *blessed man* not do?

Notice the progression from walking, to standing, to sitting. If we choose to follow evil, we become stuck in our sin and never become all we were meant to be in Christ Jesus.

According to verse 2, what two things mark a blessed man?

The word *delight* means to *be eager or zealous for, to take pleasure in, to desire or long for* (BLB).

What is the blessed man compared to?

How will you benefit from immersing yourself in the Living Water of God's Word?

A tree planted by a river will always have access to a life-sustaining source of nourishment. Even during seasons of drought, when the land is dry and thirsty, the tree will continue to thrive. We have the same promise when we walk closely to Christ. Despite hardship and trials we will continue to draw deeply from the Living Water and thrive.
